



Block Exemption

Statement According to EC Regulation 461/2010 Block Exemption Regulation (BER)

Non-Franchise Service and Repair workshops can carry out normal maintenance and repair services during a vehicle's warranty period without invalidating the vehicle assembler's warranty conditions. With two proviso's:-

- 1) Provided that the service is in accordance with the Vehicle Assembler's servicing schedules and is recorded as such.

and

- 2) Provided that the parts used are of either 'original spare parts' or 'matching quality parts' and are recorded as such.

Customers of Unipart Autoparts who carry out normal maintenance and repair services using job schedules from KiS ONLINE or from ICME Manuals can be assured that they are using Vehicle Assembler's schedules.

Customers using Unipart products;- brake pads, brake shoes, brake discs, brake drums, brake hoses, brake cables; oil, air and fuel filters; lubricants; S&S components; light bulbs & timing belts; are using parts of matching quality as certified by the manufacturers.
